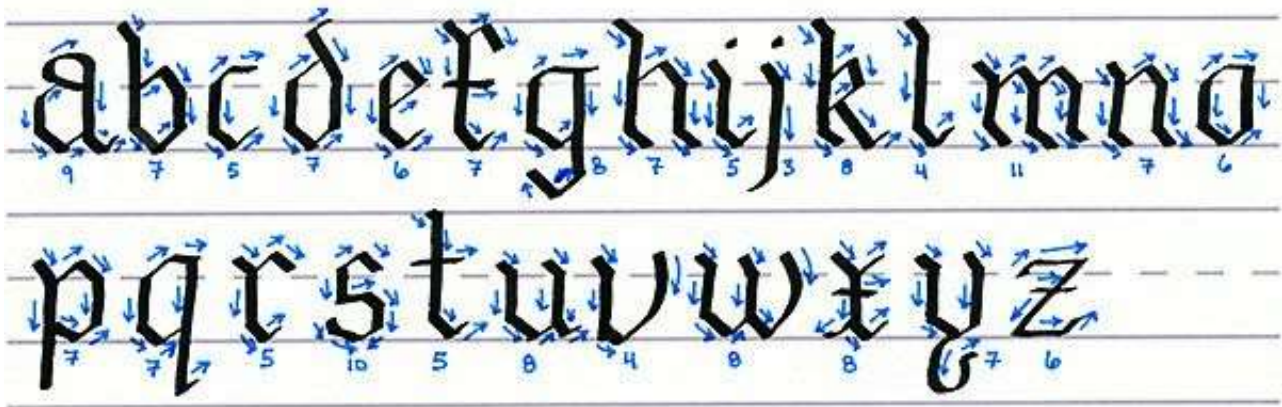
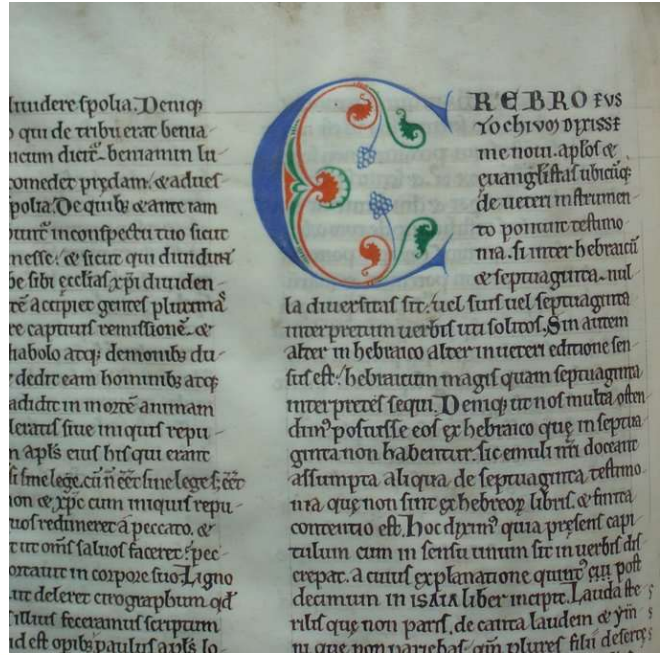


Manuscript Writing

The Magna Carta

Now you've had a chance to practice all the letters, why don't you have a go at writing out a bit of a very famous document. The Magna Carta.

What is the Magna Carta?

In 1215 the Lords of England made King John sign the Magna Carta. This document limited his powers as King, and he was forced into it by his barons after many conflicts. It has been described as forming the basis for our modern freedoms.

King John visited Worcester and stayed with the monks on several occasions, including Christmas 1214. He died in 1216 and in his will requested to be buried at the Cathedral. His tomb is at the East end of the Quire and his will is kept in our Library.

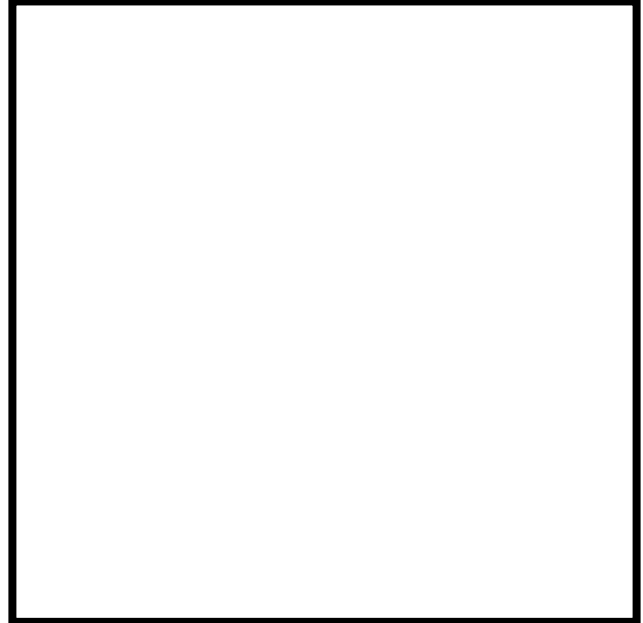
Copying the Magna Carta

After the Magna Carta was signed it would have been copied many times and distributed around the Kingdom. Can you have a go at copying one of the most famous passages, in medieval style.

No free man shall be seized or imprisoned, or stripped of his rights or possessions, or outlawed or exiled . nor will we proceed with force against him . except by the lawful judgement of his equals or by the law of the land. To no one will we sell, to no one deny or delay right or justice.

Illuminating

Imagine having to spend long periods of your day copying like a monk. Copying might have got a bit boring and so they like to liven up their day by making some of the starting letters look very attractive, just like the C in the picture at the top of this document. This was called illuminating. Why not have a go at this with our letter W (for Worcester) or create your own one in the box below.
