**\*\*start with number 10 today**

Begin your journey underneath our big window at the west end of the building - this is the first stop on your safari.





Start by looking down at the floor

Due to changes in the path round the Cathedral it is not possible to do all the Safari Trail activities and you might need to do some in the wrong order.

Start with number 10 – then go straight to Number 2.

Draw one of the birds.

Now use your map to find the second stop on the trail

In the stained glass window behind the font there is a picture of Noah's Ark.

What two big animals can you see on the right?

CLUE:   R  F

Look for the place where the priest stands to talk to the people (this is called a PULPIT).

Now find the eagle at the entrance to the Quire.

\*\* you may need to do number 5 after 6 on your way down the North Aisle

### SAFARI QUIZ

Unjumble the letters below to find out what metal the eagle is made from:

S R A B S

The misericords are carved wooden seats around the outside of the Quire that monks would have sat on.

Look at the seats and see if you can find some strange animals. Have a go at drawing one of the animals you have spotted.

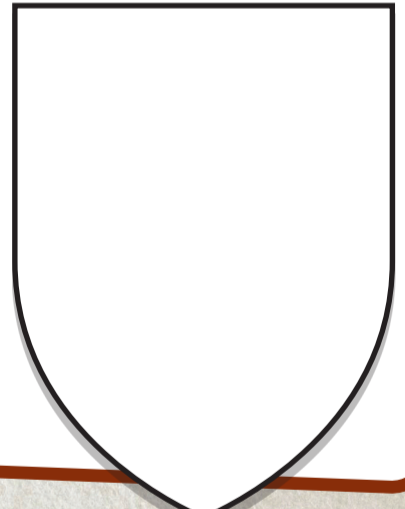
This is the tomb of King John, who ruled England between 1199 and 1216. He is one of England's most unpopular kings and is famous for agreeing to Magna Carta (meaning 'the Great Charter'), a document that limited a king's powers for the first time.

### SAFARI QUIZ

What object is the lion at King John's feet biting?

CLUE:  W   D

Find one of the shields on the sides of King John's tomb. Have a go at drawing it in the empty shield here.



Onwards to stop 7

In the Lady Chapel, which is at the far east end of the Cathedral, look for the tomb of Lord Lyttelton.

### SAFARI QUIZ

\*\* you can't access the Lady Chapel currently, so instead of number 7 try this:

From point number 6 look around. Can you see any wooden animals? Maybe where people might have a rest? They maybe mythical animals!

Draw one in box number 7



Continue this way to stop number 8

Stand outside the Jesus Chapel and look up high. Can you spy a pelican on the left?

\*\* you can't go into the Jesus Chapel, but just outside is a picture of what you might see.

A statue of Saint Wulfstan, who is the founder of the Cathedral

### SAFARI QUIZ

What type of bird is standing next to Wulfstan?

CLUE:    S

Draw the bird.
