Our main session takes place between 6.30 pm and 7.30 pm on Wednesday: here you will learn and rehearse new music, enjoy activities with the other choir members and learn about the meaning of the music that we sing.

The Voluntary Choir sings every week on Sunday in our 6.30 pm service, to which families and friends are invited. You have the opportunity to perform in Worcester Cathedral every week, and you and your family will be warmly welcomed as part of the cathedral community.

There are also opportunities to sing at events around Worcester, such as at the opening of the Christmas Fayre every year, including a ride on the carousel!
