

Services and Music February 2023

The three Sundays before Lent used to rejoice (and still do, for users of the Book of Common Prayer) in the names Septuagesima, Sexagesima, and Quinquagesima. The names mean, respectively, the Seventieth, Sixtieth, and Fiftieth days before Easter, which is a puzzling piece of arithmetic. They are now known as the Third Sunday, the Second Sunday, and the Sunday Next before Lent, which is rather dull, but the arithmetic is unarguable. In the older lectionaries (arrangements for readings through the year) the story of creation was read on Septuagesima, and there was a lovely sequence of hymns to be sung at evensong day by day throughout the period, tracing each day of creation in turn. (These hymns can be found in the English Hymnal.)

Everything that reminds us of God's creation reminds us of our responsibilities towards it, and of the Cathedral's own developing eco agenda. Sometimes we think of that solely in terms of actions. But there is also the 'action' of prayer, praying our way through our responsibility for God's creation. May the Sundays before Lent, with their memories of a 'creation season' prompt our praying for the well being of God's world.
