

Services and Music April 2023

The death and resurrection of Jesus Christ is the pivotal moment of human history. In the first few centuries of the Church, the whole passion narrative was recalled in one single liturgy that began at night and continued into Easter morning. But gradually, starting in Jerusalem where the events first took place, Christians began to relive them in real time. This is the origin of what we now call Holy Week. We begin with Palm Sunday, the entry of Jesus into Jerusalem. We continue with Maundy Thursday and the Last Supper; Good Friday and the cross; Easter, the empty tomb and our risen Lord.

In an echo of the ancient tradition, the liturgies of these Great Three Days are, strictly speaking, a single act of worship that begins on the Thursday evening and continues until Easter Day. Participating in the whole Triduum can be an extraordinarily powerful experience.

But the Easter Liturgy itself is the most important service of the Christian year. It is an especially rich feast, comprising a vigil in which we recall the saving work of God in the Old Testament, the lighting of the Easter Candle, baptism and confirmation, and finally the celebration of the Eucharist. The whole Church year builds up to this moment, everything flows from it. Do come and experience it for yourself.
