

Services and Music May 2023

There is an air of renewal and reform in the month of May – the Church's calendar remembering women and men whose faith and witness brought significant changes to our world.

Early in the month we remember the saints and martyrs of the Reformation era with penitence for all that divides us and thanksgiving for renewal in the Church. St Dunstan, who before moving to London then Canterbury was Bishop of Worcester in the 10^{th} century, is widely credited with the renewal of monastic life in England, and also with drawing up the earliest form of the English coronation service. Towards the end of the month we give thanks for John and Charles Wesley whose ministries brought revitalisation, and two days later we revisit the reformation era with our remembrance of John Calvin. And then the social reformer Josephine Butler, who campaigned to support destitute women and end human trafficking, is remembered on May 30^{th} .

In this month at Pentecost we pray for the renewing power of the Holy Spirit and find in these holy people inspiration and courage.
