December draws us once again into the deep, unfolding mystery of Advent and Christmas—a season in which the Church listens more intently, waits more expectantly, and sings more wholeheartedly than perhaps at any other time of year. In these weeks, the Cathedral becomes a place where darkness and light meet, where hope is kindled in quietness, and where the ancient story of God's coming among us is retold through Scripture, prayer, and song.

The music of the Advent season echoes the longings of the prophets and the yearning of a world in shadow. Its hymns and anthems hold space for stillness and repentance, and for the kind of attentive waiting that prepares us to recognise Christ when he draws near. As we move towards Christmas, the carols and settings of Christmas lift our hearts into joy, giving voice to the wonder of Emmanuel—God with us—dwelling in human vulnerability.

We are invited to open ourselves anew to the God who continues to come: in moments of quiet, in the lives of those we overlook, and in the unexpected places where love takes root. We pray that all who enter the Cathedral during this season—whether for a single service or through the rhythm of our worship—will find here a glimpse of the light that the darkness cannot overcome, and will be strengthened to carry that light into the world.
