

# Services and Music August 2023

Prominent in the liturgical calendar this month are the festivals of the Transfiguration of our Lord (6 August) and of the Blessed Virgin Mary (15 August).

At the Transfiguration, Moses and Elijah appear alongside Jesus, representing the Law and the Prophets. In the Old Testament, both had received a partial revelation of God; but now in the Gospels, God reveals through Jesus the fullness of his glory.

One key element of the Transfiguration was the voice from heaven: 'This is my Son, the Beloved; listen to him!' On a previous occasion, Mary had said to the servants at the wedding feast: 'Do whatever he tells you'. Jesus' Father and his mother both tell us the same thing: to follow the Son of God wherever he leads us.

In much of the Church, 15 August is celebrated as the Assumption or the Dormition of Mary, different ways of expressing the ancient and widespread belief that she was taken up bodily into heaven. Some Anglicans would be cautious about this doctrine, but it does remind us of the heavenly glory promised to all who follow Jesus. At the very least, Mary is a unique example of faith, obedience and holiness whose life continually points towards God.
