

Services and Music November 2023

We know little about St Cecilia, commemorated by the Church on 22 November. She was martyred in Rome, probably in about the year 230, though possibly rather earlier.

A later tradition relates that Cecilia was a Christian of noble birth who, against her will, was betrothed to be married to a pagan named Valerian. While the guests sang and danced at their wedding, Cecilia sat apart, reciting psalms. Later, on retiring to their bedroom, Cecilia managed to persuade her new husband to respect her vow of virginity. Indeed, Valerian and his brother were soon baptized, but came to the attention of the Roman prefect who had them beheaded. The newly widowed Cecilia then turned her home into a place of worship, in turn being arrested and sentenced to death. Repeated efforts at execution failed, and she died only after three attempts at striking off her head.

Just as she had sung at her wedding, so Cecilia also sang at her death, which is probably why from about the sixteenth century she became the patron saint of musicians. Many composers have written musical tributes to her, including Purcell, Handel, Parry, Britten and Howells, the latter setting words by Ursula Vaughan Williams:

Through the cold aftermath of centuries, Cecilia's music dances in the skies; lend us a fragment of the immortal air, that with your choiring angels we may share, a word to light us thro' time-fettered night, water of life, or rose of paradise, so from the earth another song shall rise to meet your own in heaven's long delight.
