

Services and Music April 2025

The earliest Christians commemorated the resurrection of Jesus every Sunday. But within a hundred years or so, the feast of Easter was established as a special annual celebration of the resurrection, with the date continuing to be linked to the Jewish Passover.

Easter began at sunset on the Saturday evening with a vigil throughout the night, ending at dawn with the singing of Alleluias. It quickly became a common practice for new Christians to be initiated into the life of the Church at this Easter celebration, with the preceding season of Lent originating as a time of preparation by the catechumens for their baptism.

By the middle of the fourth century, pilgrims were coming to Jerusalem to share in the 'Great Week' of what we now call Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Day. A woman named Egeria has left us an account of her pilgrimage to Jerusalem in about 381, including a description of the various prayers and devotions she encountered there during Great Week.

These liturgies and customs gradually became widespread throughout the Church. Many of the main features of the services celebrated here in Worcester during Holy Week would have been recognisable to Egeria and her contemporaries. So do come and join other pilgrims here in Worcester Cathedral as we walk alongside Jesus through Holy Week to Easter!
