'The naming of cats is a difficult matter, it isn't just one of your holiday games...' (T.S. Eliot)

So too with Saints. Who to include, who to leave out? No matter what you do there is always someone grumpy because their favourite isn't named.

This month, between Harvest and All Hallow's Eve we have a fine collection of saints: Luke the Apostle, beloved Francis; and then a whole host of English saints: bishops Paulinus and Wilfrid, King Edward and King Alfred, Tyndale and Latimer – men who shaped the very backbone of English Christianity. These are fine saints, worth celebrating. But where are the women?

I'm going to encourage you to a small act of subversion. Pray for the women saints too. On 12th October, as we remember Wilfrid, let us also remember Elizabeth Fry, who reformed the prison services, and Edith Cavell, sainted for her indiscriminate care of the wounded in WW1. If you pray for Fry during Fauxbourdon, and Cavell during 'God so loved the world', Wilfrid still gets the responses, the eucharist, and the recital. St Teresa of Avila was the first woman to be named Doctor of the Church for her teaching on prayer. Her feast day is 15th October, which falls on a Sunday. Let's get her in early on the 14th, and let prayers for her rise on Joubert's 'O Lorde, the maker of al thing'. On the 25th, the American church remembers Dorcas: the disciple named in Acts, who was known for her fine sewing and her care for the poor. It's said evening prayer that day. I suggest you bring your embroidery.
