I am writing this on the day the cathedral was transformed. At 8.45 am, I saw one member of the works team, beginning to balance a pew on a dolly. An hour later, they were all gone, and the nave was resplendent with emptiness. While it's a trick of the light, the cathedral always seems more silent and more still when the nave is empty. There is breathing space, out of which comes possibility.

We talk a lot about the music of the cathedral—and perhaps not enough about its silence. Silence is the bedrock, on which everything else is built. The priest waits for a hush before saying welcome. The organist waits for beat before offering the first note. Between phrases, between moods: there are always choices to made about how silence gets filled or exposed. And then—most magical of all—there is holy hush, when a piece is done, but the sound still lingers, and it seems that no one dares breathe till the reverberation falls.

This month, while the nave is empty, and there is space to breathe, I invite you to pay attention to the silence, before and between and beyond every note.
